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#### Day 1, Monday, March 11 - Depart from Home

Meet the rest of the group and fly from John F. Kennedy Airport in New York at 9:00 p.m. on Delta flight 268.

#### Day 2, Tuesday, March 12 – Arrive in Israel - Sharon Region and Western Galilee Prayer Day

Arrive in Ben Gurion Airport in Tel Aviv, Israel at 1:40 p.m. Meet our guide, Rev. Tom Brimmer, and take our luxury coach northward through the Sharon Plain to see a magnificent late afternoon view of the Mediterranean Sea and Haifa from Mount Carmel. Drive through and pray over the Jezreel Valley where the Battle of Armageddon will be fought, and pray over the town of Nazareth on the way to have dinner and overnight at our Kibbutz.

#### Day 3, Wednesday, March 13 – Walking Where Jesus Walked Visit The Galilee House to worship with Rania Sayegh of The Hope Prayer Center. We'll pray together as we rejoice over what the Lord is doing among both the Arab and Jewish Communities in Nazareth. Visit Capernaum and then go for a boat ride on the Sea of Galilee just as Jesus did many times, to pray over the cities and towns of Galilee. Have a lunch of St. Peter's fish (not included in tour price). There will be a special time of Baptism in the afternoon, and after dinner at our Kibbutz, we'll have a Blessing of Marriages.

Day 4, Thursday, March 14 – Northern Borders Prayer Day: Drive up on the Golan Heights to pray over the Syrian Border facing Mount Hermon at Quneitra. Visit Kibbutz EI Rom and witness the miracles God has worked for Israel at a special movie presentation. Visit Banias (Ancient Caesarea Philippi) and drive past ancient Tel Dan, praying over the Sources of the Jordan River, critical to the survival of the nation. Pray as we follow the border with Lebanon across the north of Israel and at Rosh Hanikra on the Mediterranean where Oil and Gas Reserves have recently been found! Return through the hills of beautiful Upper Galillee as the sun lights the hills with gold!

#### Day 5, Friday, March 15 – Jordan Borders Prayer Day:

Today we set our faces toward Jerusalem! Drive south to Naharaim where the Yarmuk and the Jordan Rivers come together and visit the Kibbutz there. Descend through the Jordan Valley to Qumran, where the Dead Sea Scrolls were discovered. Visit the beautiful springs at Ein Gedi where King David came to escape from Saul. You'll have time at the shores of the Dead Sea to float effortlessly in its bouyant waters or just bask in the warmth and sunlight at this, the lowest spot on the earth's surface! Then our bus will climb up the steep Judean Hills past Jericho to Jerusalem, the City of the Great King where we will pray over her people from the heights of the Mount of Olives before we arrive at our hotel, the Dan Jerusalem with its tremendous views of the city! As the Sabbath begins, feel the peace as the quiet and rest of Shabbat settles over the city.

### Day 6, Saturday (Israel's Sabbath Day), March 16 – Bethlehem and East Jerusalem Prayer Day

After breakfast at our hotel, take a special trip to the town of Bethlehem and the surrounding fields where the shepherds were watching their flocks on that night so long ago. Returning to the City of Jerusalem, visit the House of Caiaphas where Jesus was imprisoned before His crucifixion on Calvary and pray together in that room where He prayed. We'll end the day at The Garden Tomb with Communion together and then return to our hotel.

#### Day 7, Sunday, March 17 – Judea and Samaria Prayer Day

Today we visit the very heart of Israel! This is the region where most of God's covenants were made with Abraham, Isaac and Jacob, as well as the area that Israel is being pressured to give away. Let's pray, pray, pray and declare the World of God on this day! Drive to **Bethel** and pray where Jacob saw the face of God! Visit **Shiloh**, where the **Tabernacle rested for 369 years** and where Samuel first cried out, "Hineni!" "Here I am!" to the Lord. We'll pray over **Shechem** and the Biblical heartland of the nation at **Mt. Ebal and Mt. Gerizim** where the Children of Israel stood and proclaimed God's Word over the Land! Travel to **Ariel**, the largest Jewish city in this hill country of Judea and Samaria where we'll stop and visit. We'll drive back to Jerusalem and you can take part in the service of **King of Kings Congregation**, one of the largest congregations in Israel. Or if you like, you can return to the hotel and rest.

#### Day 8, Monday, March 18 – Jerusalem Prayer Day

Visit the **Pools of Bethesda**, where Jesus healed the man who had been crippled for 38 years! Join in prayer at the entrance to the ancient **Temple Mount** and at the **Western Wall** where Jewish people have sought the Lord's will for thousands of years! Eat lunch and shop in the vibrant **Jewish Quarter** of the Old City. Visit the **Israel Museum and the Shrine of the Book**, the home of the Dead Sea Scrolls and thousands of years of Jewish History. Then we will pray for the nation at **Yad VaShem**, the memorial to the victims of the Holocaust on Mount Herzl. In the evening, take part in a special **Healing Meeting** at our hotel.

#### Day 9, Tuesday, March 19 – Final Prayer Day

Our last morning in Jerusalem, we will join together in Prayer and Intercession at the End-Time Handmaidens and Servants House of Peace in Jerusalem. Then drive to Tel Aviv to the Independence Hall Museum where the modern state of Israel was first proclaimed to be "a nation born in a day"! Lunch in Tel Aviv and then shop in the artist quarter of Old Jaffa by the Sea - the oldest port in Israel, where Peter stayed in the home of Simon the Tanner. Meet with the Adonai Roi (The Lord Is My Shepherd) Congregation and hear the good news of what the Lord is doing with the people of Tel Aviv and Jaffa today! We will pray over the nation from a final beautiful view of the city. Join in a Farewell Dinner in Tel Aviv, sharing together the highlights of what God has done during this very special prayer time in His Land and then finally return to Ben Gurion for our return flight at 12:40 a.m.

#### Day 10, Wednesday, March 20 - Welcome Home!

Arrive back at John F. Kennedy in New York at 6:40 a.m., ready to return home, full of all the good things that God has done in this life-changing Hearts for Israel Prayer Journey.
