Why Coordinated Data Systems?

Data about children, families, workforce, and programs are often disconnected

A coordinated data system is part of a larger vision

- Involves many stakeholders
- Data sharing or integration
- Identify information gaps
- Policy and program planning
- Strengthens linkages among ECE services and programs as well as between ECE and other human services

- When did we move to a computerized database?
 - Built by our MIS department (management information systems)
 - Approximately 12 years ago
 - Originally one data entry person





Why?

- 19 staff entering data
- CAI R&R currently administers 10 contracts
- Each contract has specific program requirements and milestones
- 3 staff for quality control





– What is TAF?

- Reports are both statistical and narrative

 - Most accurate look at countywide needs and services
 - R&R Portfolio data represents Sacramento County

- Data Review (TAF Binder)




Future








Data Challenges and Complexities – Local Perpetuation




Regional Pilot Options for R & R

 - Using reporting functionality for submitting reports to EESD/CDTC








