The Yellowstone Association, in partnership with the National Park Service, connects people to Yellowstone National Park and our natural world through education.

Overview: During this full day professional development opportunity, you'll have the chance to interact with instructors who utilize Yellowstone National Park as both an essential tool for engagement and as a medium by which to inspire further learning and action.

Schedule: Beginning in Bozeman, the group will head directly to Yellowstone National Park and the Lamar Valley, often called Yellowstone's Serengeti, in search of wolves and other wildlife. The afternoon will be spent on an interpretive nature hike or ski/snowshoe (weather permitting). Participants will be asked to look at the entire day through the "learner's lens" and participate in discussions built around how to use outdoor spaces to inspire further learning and action.

6:30am- Meet at The Baxter Hotel for the shuttle to Yellowstone NP Morning- Head to the Lamar Valley in search of wolves and other wildlife Afternoon- Interpretive nature hike or ski/snowshoe 4:00pm- Leave YNP and Depart for Bozeman
